



International Student Application Instructions (Undergraduate only)

NOTE: International student applicants do not need to submit the \$40 USD application fee.

Students Entering as Freshmen (immediately after secondary school)

- **Official Credential Evaluation** of high school (secondary education) transcripts and [ACT](#) or [SAT](#) scores should be forwarded to the Office of Admission. Recommended service for evaluation is [Educational Perspectives](#). International students will be required to submit original high school transcripts if they choose to enroll in the university.

- **[Affidavit of Support](#)** is an official, written and signed statement from your sponsor showing proof that you will have the necessary financial support from your sponsor. (It could be a relative, organization, corporation, etc). The statement cannot be more than 6 months old. A form is provided with the [downloadable international application](#). You are also encouraged to use the [U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services I-134 form](#).
- **Official Bank Statement** is required and should be sent directly to the Office of Admission. The bank statement should be a minimum of \$29,890.00 USD for undergraduate applicants. This cost includes tuition, room and board expenses, insurance and fees, books and transportation costs for one year. The bank statement cannot be more than 6 months old.
- **Immigration Documents** are required to be photocopied and sent to the Office of Admission. Documents include passport, previous I-20s and I-94.

Students Entering as a Transfer Student (earned more than 12 semester units of academic credit)

- Official credential evaluation of transcripts (course-by-course) from all colleges/universities attended. U.S. colleges/universities do not require an evaluation and can be sent directly to the Office of Admission. Recommended service for evaluation is [Educational Perspectives](http://www.edperspective.org). Transfer students will be required to submit high school transcripts if they choose to enroll in the university.

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- **Official [TOEFL](http://www.toefl.org)** report should be sent to the Office of Admission.
